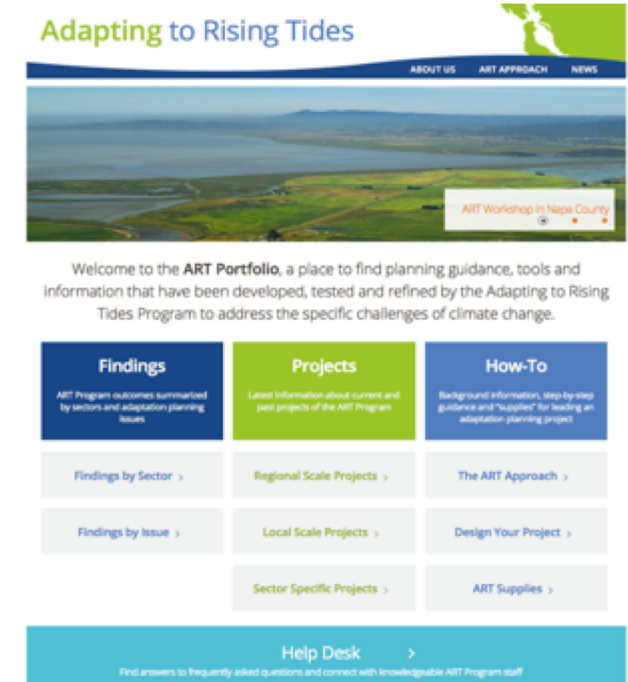

# Adapting to Rising Tides (ART)

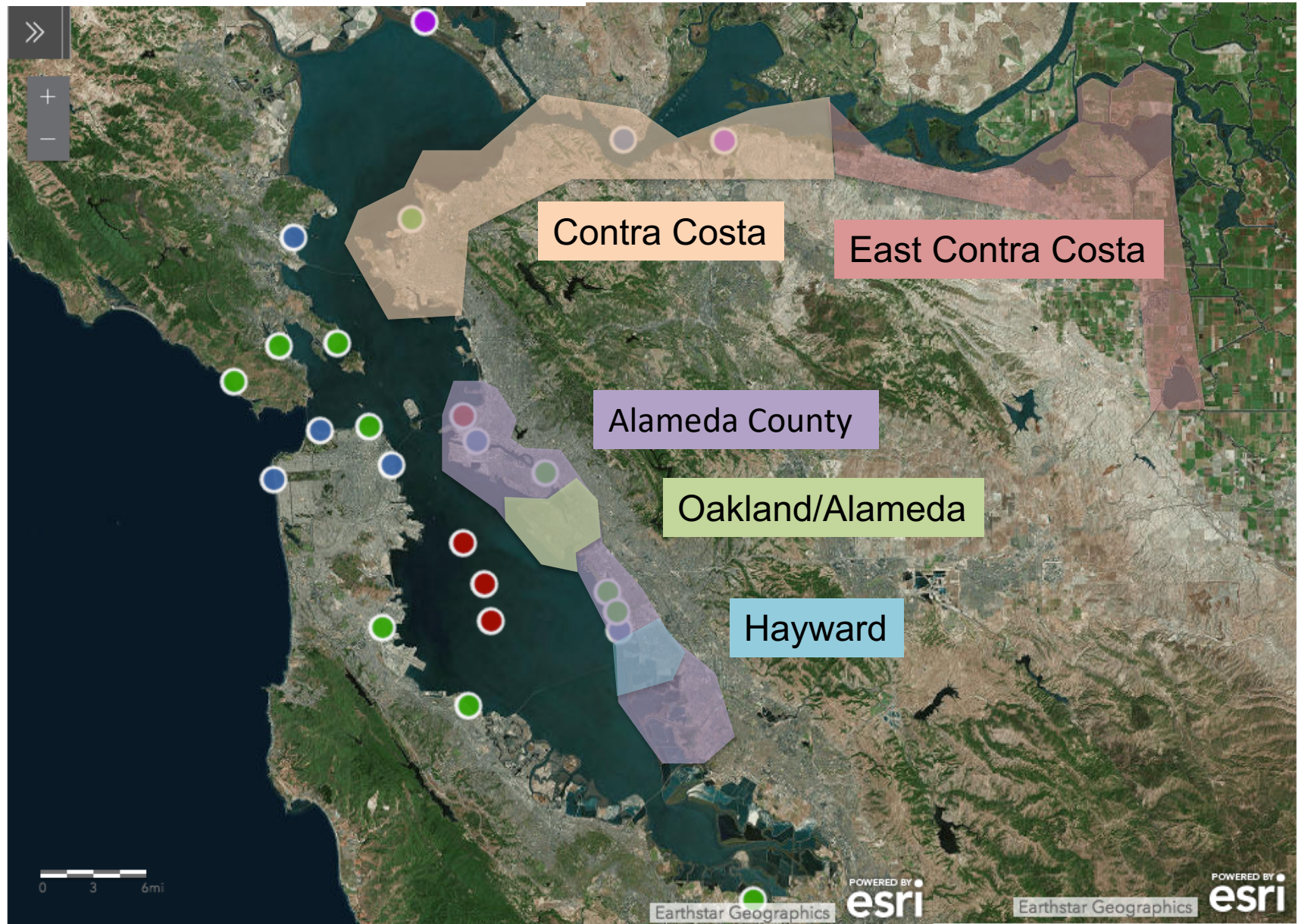
Includes:

- **How-To Guides:** for developing SLR vulnerability assessments and adaptation plans using a detailed, replicable, stakeholder-driven process



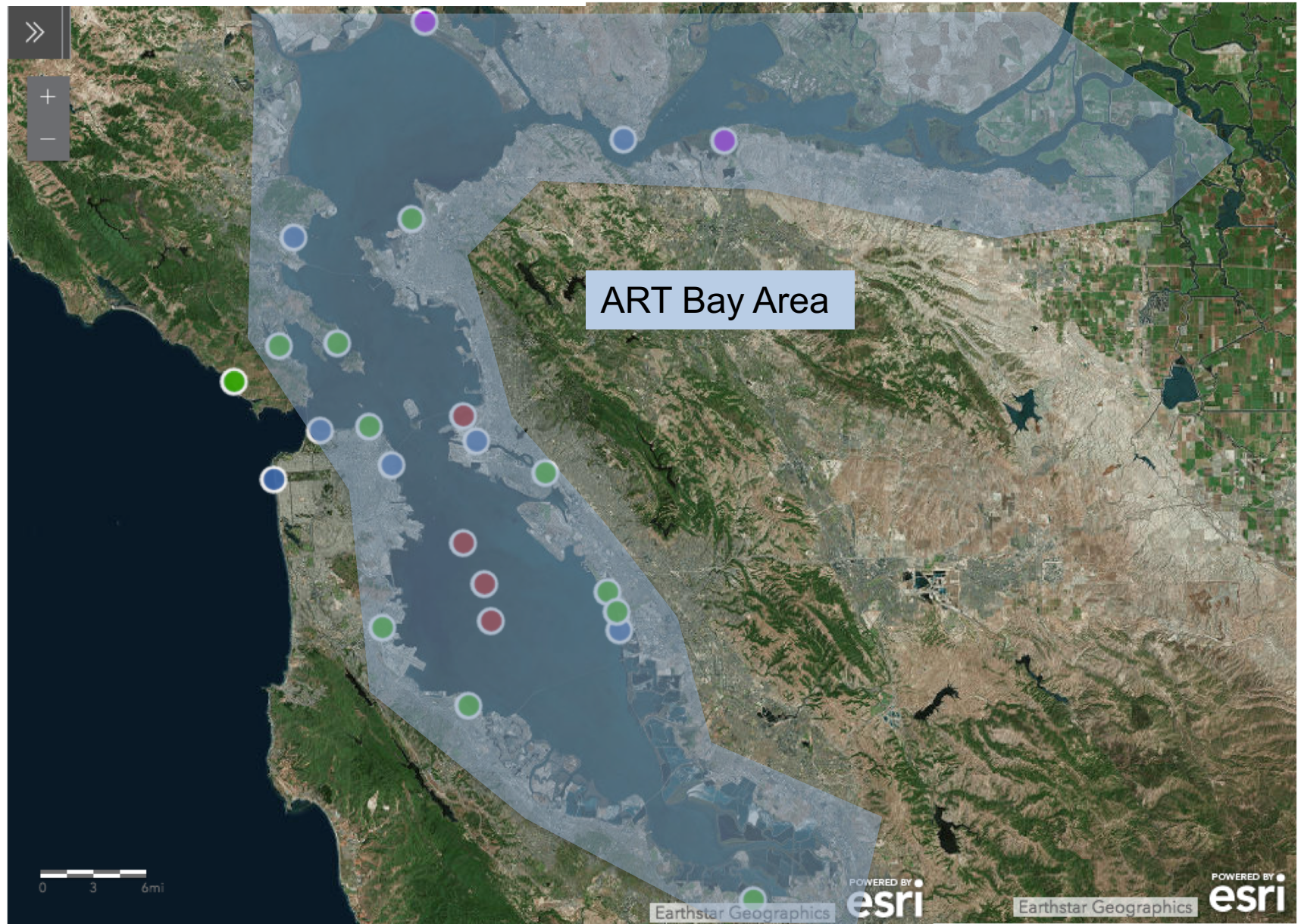

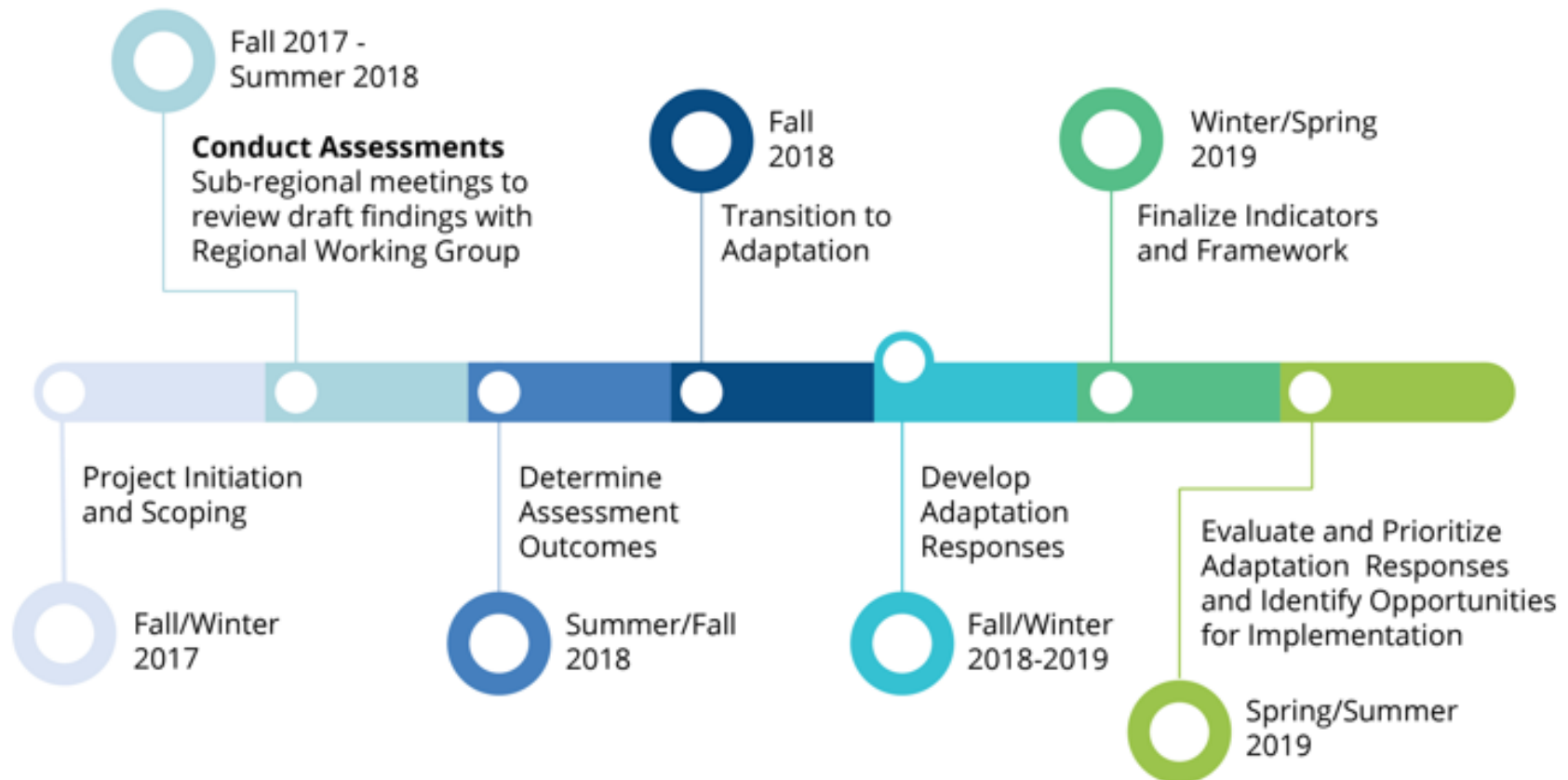
- Complete comprehensive regional-scale vulnerability assessment

Develops trust among stakeholders, shared understanding of the issues, buy-in for collaborative problem solving, and improved capacity to address issues


## A Transparent Process
